

Appleby Primary School has a uniform which all children are to wear, it consists of the following:-

ITEM	COLOUR
School Trousers (long or short)	Grey, Black or Navy Blue
School Skirt or Pinafore dress	Grey, Black or Navy Blue
Polo Shirt, Blouse or Shirt	White or Pale Blue
Gingham Checked Dress	Blue (worn during warmer weather)
School Sweatshirt or Cardigan	Royal Blue
<i>Or</i> Sweater or cardigan with no school logo	Royal Blue or Grey
Socks or Tights	Black, grey or white
Flat Black Shoes	Black

Year 6 children wear a Red Sweater or Cardigan

Open toe sandals are not suitable for school wear.

PE Uniform

For Indoor PE lessons plain coloured shorts and t-shirt together with lightweight trainers

For outdoor PE a plain coloured t-shirt and tracksuit should be worn together with trainers suitable for outdoors.

If children have their ears pierced then only stud earrings are permitted, no other jewellery should be worn in school. The Health & Safety Management in Schools guidance states that for safety reasons the wearing of earrings, ear studs or other jewellery (metal or plastic) must not be permitted during sporting activities, PE or swimming. Following this advice we must ask that children have their earrings removed before coming to school on the days they have PE. If you are considering allowing your child to have their ears pierced I would urge you to, if at all possible, have them done at the start of a summer holiday so you are able to remove them for PE. The advice also states that earrings should not be covered by microporous tape, plasters or headbands.
